Credit for DANTES Subject Standardized Tests (DSSTs)

The following institutions award credit for [DANTES Subject Standardized Tests \(DSSTs\)](#) for college-level academic subjects using the minimum score and credit amount determined by the institution's policy. Students should consult with each [individual institution](#) for more information.

Institution	Minimum Test Score	Amount of Credit	Restrictions
Alverno College	400	3 Credits per test	Alverno awards credits toward some general education requirements based on DANTES scores.
Bellin College	ACE Recommendation (400 or above)	3 credits per test	Bellin College will accept DSST Credit by Exam if the content meets specific general education degree requirements.
Concordia University	400	3 credits per test	CUW will allow up to 30 DSST transfer credits.
Edgewood College	400	3 credits for most tests	Edgewood College accepts a maximum of 60 credits for CLEP, DSST, and portfolios. Click here for more information.
Herzing University	400	3 credits per test	Herzing University allows students to transfer in up to 75% of the program credits through transfer credit and prior learning assessment. DANTES is classified as credit for prior learning assessment.
Lakeland University	See policy	See policy	Lakeland University evaluates several examinations and scores including DANTES earned as part of the review for transfer. Evaluation of credits may result in fulfillment of specific major programs requirements, general education requirements or elective credit to complete a degree.
