Credit for Basic Training The following institutions award credit for Military Basic Training. Students should consult with each individual institution for more information.

Institution	Detail of Credit Awarded
<u>Alverno</u>	Alverno College awards credits for basic military training based on the college's evaluation of ACE recommendations. Earned credits may result in fulfillment of general education requirements or elective credit to complete a degree.
<u>Bellin</u>	Bellin College will award specific degree credit through completion of Military Basic Training. Credit earned through military experience may meet specific degree requirements with appropriate documentation. Completion of Military Basic Training must be verified with the provision of one of the following: Joint Services Transcript (JST), Community College of the Air Force (CCAF) Transcript, or Discharge or Separation documentation from Active Duty, DD Form 214.
<u>Carroll</u>	Carroll University will award credit for Basic Training in accordance with the ACE recommendations on the Joint Service Transcript. Basic Training credits is also awarded for Air Force personnel based on the evaluation of the Community College of the Air Force transcript.
<u>Concordia</u>	Concordia University Wisconsin (CUW) will award credit for Basic Training in accordance with the ACE recommended evaluation for Joint Service Transcripts (JST). For Air Force personnel, Basic Training credits will be determined by the Community College of the Air Force (CCAF) transcript.
<u>Edgewood</u>	Edgewood University awards credit for Basic Training courses with a liberal arts focus based on ACE recommendations.
<u>Herzing</u>	Herzing University awards credit for Military Basic Training based on the ACE recommendations on the Joint Services Transcript. The amount of credit awarded will vary based on the student's program of study.
<u>Lakeland</u>	Lakeland University evaluates all military training and post-secondary credit earned as part of the review for transfer.

Credit for Basic Training The following institutions award credit for Military Basic Training. Students should consult with each individual institution for more information.

Institution	Detail of Credit Awarded
<u>Marian</u>	Marian University evaluates all military training and post-secondary credit earned as part of the review for transfer.
<u>Marquette</u>	Marquette University awards Military Science & Leadership (MISL) credit for Basic Training in accordance with the ACE recommendations appearing on the Joint Service Transcript (JST). For Air Force personnel, Basic Training is awarded Air Force Aerospace Studies (AFAS) elective credit based on evaluation of the Community College of the Air Force (CCAF) transcript.
<u>Mount Mary</u>	Mount Mary University will award up to 12 credits for basic military training and education. Credits may be awarded based upon ACE recommendations for work recorded on the official Joint Services or Community College of the Air Force transcript.
<u>Ripon</u>	Ripon College awards elective transfer credit for Basic Training with consideration of the ACE recommendations appearing on the Joint Service Transcript.
<u>St. Norbert</u>	St. Norbert College awards up to six credits for basic training from any military branch. These credits are evaluated based on ACE recommendations and awarded in areas such as Physical Education, Leadership, Military Science and Peace and Justice.
<u>Viterbo</u>	Viterbo University will award up to six credits for Basic Combat Training in accordance with the ACE recommended evaluation on the Joint Services Transcript (JST). For Air Force personnel, credits will be determined after review of the Community College of the Air Force (CCAF) transcript.
<u>Wisconsin Lutheran</u>	Wisconsin Lutheran College accepts up to 6 credits for military training according to the recommendations of the American Council on Education (ACE) and the Joint Military Services/Community College of the Air Force transcripts.
